## CHAPTER 60

## KNITTED OR CROCHETED FABRICS

## Notes:

1. This Chapter does not cover:
(a) Crochet lace of heading 58.04;
(b) Labels, badges or similar articles, knitted or crocheted, of heading 58.07; or
(c) Knitted or crocheted fabrics, impregnated, coated, covered or laminated, of Chapter 59. However, knitted or crocheted pile fabrics, impregnated, coated, covered or laminated, remain classified in heading 60.01 .
2. This Chapter also includes fabrics made of metal thread and of a kind used in apparel, as furnishing fabrics or for similar purposes.
3. Throughout the Nomenclature any reference to "knitted" goods includes a reference to stitchbonded goods in which the chain stitches are formed of textile yarn.

## Sub Heading Notes:

1. Subheading 6005.35 covers fabrics of polyethylene monofilament or of polyester multifilament, weighing not less than $30 \mathrm{~g} / \mathrm{m}^{2}$ and not more than $55 \mathrm{~g} / \mathrm{m}^{2}$, having mesh size of not less than 20 holes/ $\mathrm{cm}_{2}$ and not more than 100 holes $/ \mathrm{cm}^{2}$, and impregnated or coated with alpha-cypermethrin (ISO), chlorfenapyr (ISO), deltamethrin (INN, ISO), lambda-cyhalothrin (ISO), or prirmiphosmethyl (ISO).

## CHAPTER 61 <br> ARTICLES OF APPAREL AND CLOTHING ACCESSORIES; KNITTED OR CROCHETED

Notes:

1. This Chapter applies only to made up knitted or crocheted articles.
2. This Chapter does not cover:
(a) Goods of heading 62.12;
(b) Worn clothing or other worn articles of heading 63.09; or
(c) Orthopedic appliances, surgical belts, trusses or the like (heading 90.21).
3. For the purposes of heading61.03 and 61.04;
(a) The term "suit" means a set of garments composed of two or three pieces made up, in respect of their outer surface, in identical fabric and comprising:

- one suit coat or jacket the outer shell of which, exclusive of sleeves, consists of four or more panels, designed to cover the upper part of the body, possibly with a tailored waistcoat in addition whose front is made from the same fabric as the outer surface of the other components of the set and whose back is made from the same fabric as the lining of the suit coat or jacket; and
- one garment designed to cover the lower part of the body and consisting of trousers, breeches or shorts (other than swimwear), a skirt or a divided skirt, having neither braces nor bibs.

All of the components of a "suit" must be of the same fabric construction, colour and composition; they must also be of the same style and of corresponding or compatible size. However, these components may have piping (a strip of fabric sewn into the seam) in a different fabric.

If several separate components to cover the lower part of the body are presented together (for example, two pairs of trousers or trousers and shorts, or a skirt or divided skirt and trousers), the constituent lower part shall be one pair of trousers or, in the case of women's or girls' suits, the skirt or divided skirt, the other garments being considered separately.

The term "suit" includes the following sets of garment, whether or not they fulfil all the above conditions:

- morning dress, comprising a plain jacket (cutaway) with rounded tails hanging well down at the back and striped trousers;
- evening dress (tailcoat), generally made of black fabric, the jacket of which is relatively short at the front, does not close and has narrow skirts cut in at the hips and hanging down behind;
- dinner jacket suits, in which the jacket is similar in style to an ordinary jacket (though perhaps revealing more of the shirt front), but has shiny silk or imitation silk lapels.
(b) The term "ensemble" means a set of garments (other than suits and articles of heading 61.07, 61.08 or 61.09 ), composed of several pieces made up in identical fabric, put up for retail sale, and comprising:
- One garment designed to cover the upper part of the body, with the exception of pullovers which may form a second upper garment in the sole context of twin sets, and of waistcoats which may also form a second upper garment, and
- one or two different garments, designed to cover the lower part of the body and consisting of trousers, bib and brace overalls, breeches, shorts (other than swimwear), a skirt or a divided skirt.

All of the components of an ensemble must be of the same fabric construction, style, colour and composition; they also must be of corresponding or compatible size. The term "ensemble" dose not apply to track suits or ski suits, of heading 61.12.
4. Heading 61.05 and 61.06 do not cover garments with pockets below the waist, with a ribbed waistband or other means of tightening at the bottom of the garment, or garments having an average of less than 10 stitches per linear centimetre in each direction counted on an area measuring a least $10 \mathrm{~cm} \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$. Heading 61.05 does not cover sleeveless garments.
"Shirts" and "shirt-blouses" are garments designed to cover the upper part of the body, having long or short sleeves and a full or partial opening starting at the neckline. "Blouses" are loosefitting garments also designed to cover the upper part of the body but may be sleeveless and with or without an opening at the neckline. "Shirts", "shirt-blouses" and "blouses" may also have a collar.
5. Heading $\mathbf{6 1 . 0 9}$ does not cover garments with a drawstring, ribbed waistband or other means of tightening at the bottom of the garment.
6. For the purposes of heading 61.11:
(a) The expression "babies' garments and clothing accessories" means articles for young children of a body height not exceeding 86 cm ;
(b) Articles which are, prima facie, classifiable both in heading $\mathbf{6 1 . 1 1}$ and in other headings of this Chapter are to be classified in heading 61.11.
7. For the purposes of heading 61.12, "ski suits" means garments or sets of garments which, by their general appearance and texture, are identifiable as intended to be worn principally for skiing (cross country or alpine). They consist either of:
(a) a "ski overall", that is, a one-piece garment designed to cover the upper and the lower parts of the body; in addition to sleeves and a collar the ski overall may have pockets or footstraps; or
(b) a "ski ensemble", that is, a set of garments composed of two or three pieces, put up for retail sale and comprising:

- One garment such as an anorak, wind-cheater, wind-jacket or similar article, closed by a slide fastener (zipper), possibly with a waistcoat in addition, and
- one pair of trousers whether or not extending above waist-level, one pair of breeches or one bib and brace overall.
The "ski ensemble" may also consist of an overall similar to the one mentioned in paragraph (a) above and a type of padded, sleeveless jacket worn over the overall.
All of the components of a "ski-ensemble" must be made up in a fabric of the same texture, style and composition whether or not of the same colour; they also must be of corresponding or compatible size.

8. Garments which are, prima facie, classifiable both in heading $\mathbf{6 1 . 1 3}$ and in other headings of this Chapter, excluding heading 61.11, are to be classified in heading 61.13.
9. Garments of this Chapter designed for left over right closure at the front shall be regarded as men's o boys' garments, and those designed for right over left closure at the front as women's or girls' garments. These provisions do not apply where the cut of the garment clearly indicates that it is designed for one or other of the sexes.

Garments which cannot be identified as either men's or boys' garments or as women's or girls' garments are to be classified in the headings covering women's or girls' garments.
10. Articles of this Chapter may be made of metal threa

## CHAPTER 62 <br> ARTICLES OF APPAREDL AND CLOTHING ACCESSORIES, NOT KNITTED OR CROCHETED

## Notes:

1. This Chapter applies only to made up articles of any textile fabric other than wadding, excluding knitted or crocheted articles (other than those of heading 62.12).
2. This Chapter does not cover:
(a) Worn clothing or other worn articles of heading 63.09; or
(b) Orthopaedic appliances, surgical belts, trusses or the like (heading 90.21).
3. For the purposes of headings $\mathbf{6 2 . 0 3}$ and 62.04:
(a) The term "suit" means a set of garments composed of two or three pieces made up, in respect of their outer surface, in identical fabric and comprising:

- one suit coat of jacket the outer shell of which, exclusive of sleeves, consists of four or more panels, designed to cover the upper part of the body, possibly with a tailored waistcoat in addition whose front is made from the same fabric as the outer surface of the other components of the set and whose back is made from the same fabric as the lining of the suit coat or jacket; and
- one garment designed to cover the lower part of the body and consisting of trousers, breeches or shorts (other than swimwear), a skirt or a divided skirt, having neither braces nor bibs.

All of the components of a "suit" must be of the same fabric construction, colour and composition; they must also be of the same style and of corresponding or compatible size However, these components may have piping (a strip of fabric sewn into the seam) in a different fabric.

If several separate components to cover the lower part of the body are presented together (for example, two pairs of trousers or trousers and shorts, or a skirt or divided skirt and trousers), the constituent lower part shall be one pair of trousers or, in the case of women's or girls' suits, the skirt or divided skirt, the other garments being considered separately.

The term "suit" includes the following sets of garments, whether or not they fulfil all the above conditions:

- morning dress, comprising a plain jacket (cutaway) with rounded tails hanging well down at the back and striped trousers;
- evening dress (tailcoat), generally made of black fabric, the jacket of which is relatively short at the front, does not close and has narrow skirts cut in at the hips and hanging down behind;
- dinner jacket sits, in which the jacket is similar in style to an ordinary jacket (though perhaps revealing more of the shirt front), but has shiny silk or imitation silk lapels.
(b) The term "ensemble" means a set of garments (other than suits and articles of heading 62.07 or 62.08) composed of several pieces made up in identical fabric, put up for retail sale, and comprising:
- one garment designed to cover the upper part of the body, with the exception of waistcoats which may also form a second upper garment, and
- one or two different garments, designed to cover the lower part of the body and consisting of trousers, bib and brace overalls, breeches, shorts (other than swimwear), a skirt or a divided skirt.

All of the components of an ensemble must be of the same fabric construction, style, colour and composition; they must also be of corresponding or compatible size The term "ensemble" does not apply to track suits or ski suits, of heading 62.11.
4. Headings 62.05 and 62.06 do not cover garments with pockets below the waist, with a ribbed waistband or other means of tightening at the bottom of the garment. Heading $\mathbf{6 2 . 0 5}$ does not cover sleeveless garments.
"Shirts" and "shirt-blouses" are garments designed to cover the upper part of the body, having long or short sleeves and a ful or partial opening starting at the neckline. "Blouses" are loosefitting garments also designed to cover the upper part of the body but may be sleeveless and with or without an opening at the neckline. "Shirts", "shirt-blouses" and "blouses" may also have a collar.
5. For the purposes of heading 62.09:
(a) The expression "babies garments and clothing accessories" means articles for young children of a body height not exceeding 86 cm ;
(b) Articles which are, prima facie, classifiable both in heading $\mathbf{6 2 . 0 9}$ and in other headings of this Chapter are to be classified in heading 62.09.
6. Garment which are, prima facie, classifiable both in heading $\mathbf{6 2 . 1 0}$ and in other headings of the Chapter excluding heading 62.09, are to be classified in heading 62.10.
7. For the purposes of heading 62.11, "ski suits" means garments or sets of garments which, by their general appearance and texture, are identifiable as intended to be worn principally for skiing (cross-country or alpine). They consist either of:
(a) a "ski overall", that is, a one-piece garment designed to cover the upper and the lower parts of the body; in addition to sleeves and a collar the ski overall may have pockets or footstraps; or
(b) a "ski ensemble", that is, a set of garments composed of two or three pieces, put up for retail sale and comprising:

- one garment such as an anorak, wind-cheater, wind-jacket or similar article, closed by a slide fastener (zipper), possibly with a waistcoat in addition, and
- one pair of trousers whether or not extending above waist-level, one pair of breeches or one bib and brace overall.

The "ski ensemble" may also consist of an overall similar to the one mentioned in paragraph (a) above and a type of padded, sleeveless jacket worn over the overall.
All of the components of "ski ensemble" must be made up in a fabric of the same texture, style and composition whether or not of the same colour, they also must be of corresponding or compatible size.
8. Scarves and articles of the scarf type, square or approximately square, of which no side exceeds 60 cm , are to be classified as handkerchiefs (heading 62.13). Handkerchiefs of which any side exceeds 60 cm are to be classified in heading $\mathbf{6 2 . 1 4}$.
9. Garments of this Chapter designed for left over right closure at the front shall be regarded as men's or boys' garments, and those designed for right over left closure at the front as women's or girls'garments. These provisions do not apply where the cut of the garment clearly indicates that it is designed for one or other of the sexes.

Garments which cannot be identified as either men's or boys' garments or as women's or girls' garments are to be classified in the headings covering women's or girls' garments.
10. Articles of this Chapter may be made of metal thread.

## CHAPTER 63 <br> OTHER MADE UP TEXTILE ARTICLES; SETS; WORN CLOTHING AND WORN TEXTILE ARICLES; RAGS

## Notes:

2. Sub-Chapter I does not cover:
(a) Goods of Chapters 56 to 62; or
(b) Worn clothing or other worn articles of heading 63.09.
3. Heading 63.09 applies only to the following goods:
(a) Articles of textile materials:
(I) Clothing and clothing accessories, and parts thereof;
(II) Blankets and travelling rugs;
(III) Bed linen, table linen, toilet linen and kitchen linen;
(IV)Furnishing articles, other than carpets of headings 57.01 to 57.05 and tapestries of heading 58.05;
(b) Footwear and headgear of any material other than asbestos.

In order to be classified in this heading, the articles mentioned above must comply with both of the following requirements:
(i) they must show signs of appreciable wear, and
(ii) they must be presented in bulk or in bales, sacks or similar packings.

Sub Heading Notes:

1. Subheading 6304.20 covers articles made from warp knit fabrics, impregnated or coated with alpha-cypermethrin (ISO), chlorfenapyr (ISO), deltamethrin (INN,ISO), lambda-cyhalothrin (ISO), permethrin (ISO) or pirmiphos-methyl (ISO).

## CHAPTER 64

(b) Footwear of textile material, without an outer sole glued, sewn or otherwise affixed or applied to the upper (Section XI).
(c) Worn footwear of heading 63.09;
(d) Articles of asbestos (heading 68.12);
(e) Orthopaedic footwear or other orthopaedic appliances, or parts thereof (heading 90.21); or
(f) Toy footwear or skating boots with ice or roller skates attached; shin-guards or similar protective sportswear (Chapter 95).
2. For the purposes of heading 64.06, the term "parts" does not include pegs, protectors, eyelets, hooks, buckles, ornaments, braid, laces, pompons or other trimmings (which are to be classified in their appropriate headings) or buttons or other goods of heading 96.06.
3. For the purposes of this Chapter:
(a) the terms "rubber" and "plastics" include woven fabrics or other textile products with an external layer of rubber or plastics being visible to the naked eye; for the purpose of this provision, no account should be taken of any resulting change of colour; and
(b) the terms "leather" refers to the goods of heading 41.04 to 41.09 .
4. Subject to note $\mathbf{3}$ to this Chapter:
(a) The material of the upper shall be taken to be the constituent material having the greatest external surface area, no account being taken of accessories or reinforcements such as ankle patches, edging, ornamentation, buckles, tabs, eyelet stays or similar attachments;
(b) the constituent material of the outer also shall be taken to be the material having the greatest surface area in contact with the ground, no account being taken of accessories or reinforcements such as spikes, bars, nails, protectors or similar attachments.

## Subheading Note:

1. For the purposes of subheadings $\mathbf{6 4 0 2 . 1 2}, \mathbf{6 4 0 2 . 1 9}, \mathbf{6 4 0 3 . 1 2}, 6403.19$ and $\mathbf{6 4 0 4 . 1 1}$, the expression "sports footwear" applies only to:
(a) footwear which is designed for a sporting activity and has, or has provision for the attachment of, spikes, sprigs, stops, clips, bars or the like.
(b) skating boots, ski-boots and cross-country ski footwear, snowboard boots, wrestling boots, boxing boots and cycling shoes.

## CHAPTER 69 CERAMIC PRODUCTS

Notes:

## CHAPTER 70 <br> GLASS AND GLASSWARE

## Notes:

## 1. This Chapter does not cover:

(a) Goods of heading 32.07 (for example, vitrifiable enamels and glazes, glass frit, other glass in the form of powder, granules or flakes);
(b) Articles of Chapter 71 (for example, imitation jewellery);
(c) Optical fibre cables of heading 85.44 , electrical insulators (heading 85.46) or fittings of insulating material of heading 85.47;
(d) Front windscreens (windshields), rear windows and other windows, framed, for vehicles of Chapters 86 to 88;
(e) Front windscreens (windshields), rear windows and other windows, whether or not framed, incorporating heated devices or other electrical or electronic devices, for vehicles of Chapters 86 to 88;
(f) Optical fibres, optically worked optical elements, hypodermic syringes, artificial eyes, thermometers, barometers, hydrometers or other articles of Chapter 90;
(g) Luminaires or lighting fittings, illuminated signs, illuminated name-plates or the like, having a permanently fixed light source, or parts thereof of heading 94.05;
(h) Toys, games, sports requisites, Christmas tree ornaments or other articles of Chapter 95 (excluding glass eyes without mechanisms for dolls or for other articles of Chapter 95); or
(ij) Buttons, fitted vacuum flasks, scent or similar sprays or other articles of Chapter 96.
2. For the purposes of heading 70.03, 70.04 and 70.05:
(a) glass is not regarded as "worked" by reason of any process it has undergone before annealing;
(b) cutting to shape does not affect the classification of glass in sheets;
(c) the expression "absorbent, reflecting or non-reflecting layer" means a microscopically thin coating of metal or of a chemical compound (for example, metal oxide) which absorbs, for example, infra-red light or improves the reflecting qualities of the glass while still allowing it to retain a degree of transparency of translucency; or which prevents light from being reflected on the surface of the glass.
3. The products referred to in heading 70.06 remain classified in that heading whether or not they have the character of articles.
4. For the purposes of heading 70.19, the expression "glass wool" means:
(a) Mineral wools with a silica $\left(\mathbf{S i O}_{2}\right)$ content not less than $\mathbf{6 0 \%}$ by weight.
(b) Mineral wools with a silica ( $\mathbf{S i O}_{2}$ ) content less than $60 \%$ but with an alkaline oxide $\left(\mathrm{K}_{2} \mathrm{O}\right.$ or $\mathrm{Na}_{2} \mathrm{O}$ ) content exceeding $5 \%$ by weight or a boric oxide $\left(\mathrm{B}_{2} \mathrm{O}_{3}\right)$ content exceeding $2 \%$ by weight.

Mineral wools which do not comply with the above specifications fall in heading 68.06.
5. Throughout the Nomenclature, the expression "glass" includes fused quartz and other fused silica.
